



Game Day Experience Frequently Asked Questions

Q.: When do parking lots open?

A.: Unless otherwise specified, gates open at 7 a.m. the day of game.

Q.: Is reserved parking available?

A.: Lot 44 is designated for reserved spots for MVP-level Stampede Club members and VIPs. For information on becoming an MVP Stampede Club member check out centralconnection.org/athletics. All other areas are open to the general public.

Q.: Is handicapped parking available?

A.: Yes, there are handicapped spots available in Lot 53 (west of Wantland) and Lot 44 (south of Wantland). A handicapped placard card must be visible from vehicle.

Q.: Are there any restrictions on tent sizes?

A.: We encourage fans to use tents no larger than 10' x 10'.

Q.: When do I have to take down my tent?

A.: Because unexpected winds can cause tents to scatter when unattended, tents should be taken down before you enter the game.

Q.: When do I have to leave the parking lot?

A.: We know you love a good tailgate but we do ask that you clear the parking lots no later than 90 minutes after the end of the football game. Our crews need to get the lots cleaned and ready for next week's classes.

Q.: Can I bring glass bottles to my tailgate?

A.: Plastic is fantastic! Glass containers are not allowed during tailgating activities. Broken glass can be a safety hazard for tailgaters and for students on campus during the week.

Q.: Can I play music at my tailgate?

A.: Yes! But, music should be confined to your tailgate area and speakers should be directed into your tailgate party. Tailgaters are encouraged to contact UCO police if music from another tailgate party becomes a nuisance.

Q.: Can I take food or beverages into the stadium?

A.: No outside food or beverages may be taken into Wantland Stadium.

Q.: Can I buy tickets to the game online?

A.: Yes! Tickets are available online at bronchosports.com/tickets.

Q.: When do the stadium gates open?

A.: Wantland Stadium gates open 90 minutes before kickoff.

Q.: What do I do if I see something that concerns me?

A.: See Something, Say Something! If you see something that concerns you, contact the UCO police at 405-974-2345.

Q.: Is there a time limit on Game Day alcohol consumption?

A.: Yes, alcohol consumption in parking lots and designated tailgating areas are encouraged to stop at kickoff. State laws require that all persons consuming alcohol be at least 21 years of age.

Q.: What type of alcohol can I bring to my tailgate?

A.: Alcohol is restricted to cereal malt beverages in 12 oz. cans. Bulk containers such as kegs of any size and other similar containers are not allowed. You may not sell alcohol at UCO tailgates, unless you have special permission from the university.

Q.: Do I need a special cooler or container to transport beverages into my tailgate?

A.: No. Although we do encourage fans to show their Broncho Pride by using coolers that are bronze and blue in color.

Q.: Can I bring my beer bong?

A.: No. UCO tailgaters understand the importance of being responsible. This is why they leave their beer bongs, funnels or any other device intended to increase the speed at which alcohol is consumed at home. Drinking games such as beer pong are also not allowed.

Q.: Can I bring my living room couch to my tailgate?

A.: No. Please leave your couch, recliner, bunk bed, and any other type of furniture that is designed for interior household use where it belongs... in a house. Please limit your seating to collapsible chairs.
